TUESDAY, MAY 21- ONGOING THE ENSLAVED AT RACKLIFFE HOUSE AND WORCESTER COUNTY, MARYLAND: A LOCAL STORY

At: 1/2-mile from the Assateague Island Visitor Center on Rt. 611, Public and private records, as well as archaeological evidence, show the vital role that African Americans played. They were the economic engine that helped to create and sustain the wealth of 18th-century estates like this one. This exhibition covers the time from the colonial period until about 1870. It also tells a local story, focusing on Rackliffe and neighboring estates, as well as other areas of Worcester County. Tours are available on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 1-4.
