Federal One Big Beautiful Bill Signed into Law

The **One Big Beautiful Bill** that was recently signed into law includes No Tax on Tips and No Tax on Overtime, which will provide additional tax deductions for tipped servers and bartenders, and hourly employees who earn overtime premium pay. Additional information for employers and employees will be provided after the Department of the Treasury and IRS release related regulations and guidance (expected in early October).

Tax provisions in the bill critical to restaurant operators include:

- Full expensing for capital equipment purchases
- 20% qualified business income (QBI) deduction
- Business interest expense deduction
- Permanent family and medical leave tax credits
- Estate tax relief
- No Taxes on Tips and No Taxes on Overtime for servers/bartenders earning tips and overtime premium pay for hourly earners.


