Maryland Workforce Exchange

FREE – This site was specifically designed for job seekers, students, case managers, employers, training providers, workforce professionals, and others seeking benefits and services.

American Job Center (AJC)

FREE – The centers provide an array of high-quality services so that workers, job seekers, and businesses can conveniently find the help they need under one roof in easy to reach locations. With a variety of partner programs available, it is designed to help businesses find qualified workers and to help job seekers obtain employment and training services to enhance their careers.

SU - Applied Business Learning Experience (ABLE)

FREE / LOW-COST – An Applied Business Learning Experience that is designed to give students on-the-job experience and includes a faculty guided class that must be taken at the same time a student is completing a work site internship. Internships can be unpaid or paid.
